The Host Program

The Host Program offers enthusiastic, social volunteers the chance to camp and have fun in beautiful, diverse park settings while gaining experience in park operations and visitor services. Hosts are needed seasonally at Fay Bainbridge Park.

What will I be doing?

As a host, you will be representing the Park District by greeting the public park users and helping set the tone for a pleasant stay! Hosts assist the park staff and perform a variety of tasks. These tasks vary for different parks and host assignments.



Where do I stay?

Hosts receive *free* camping *and* hookups in exchange for their hard work performing their assigned duties. A typical host assignment is 30 days. This can be extended up to 90 days at the park manager's discretion. Hosts must provide their own RV and camping equipment.

Would I make a good host?

Hosts should enjoy working with the public, have the desire to accept new challenges, and possess the willingness to learn about the Bainbridge Island Metro Park and Recreation District.
