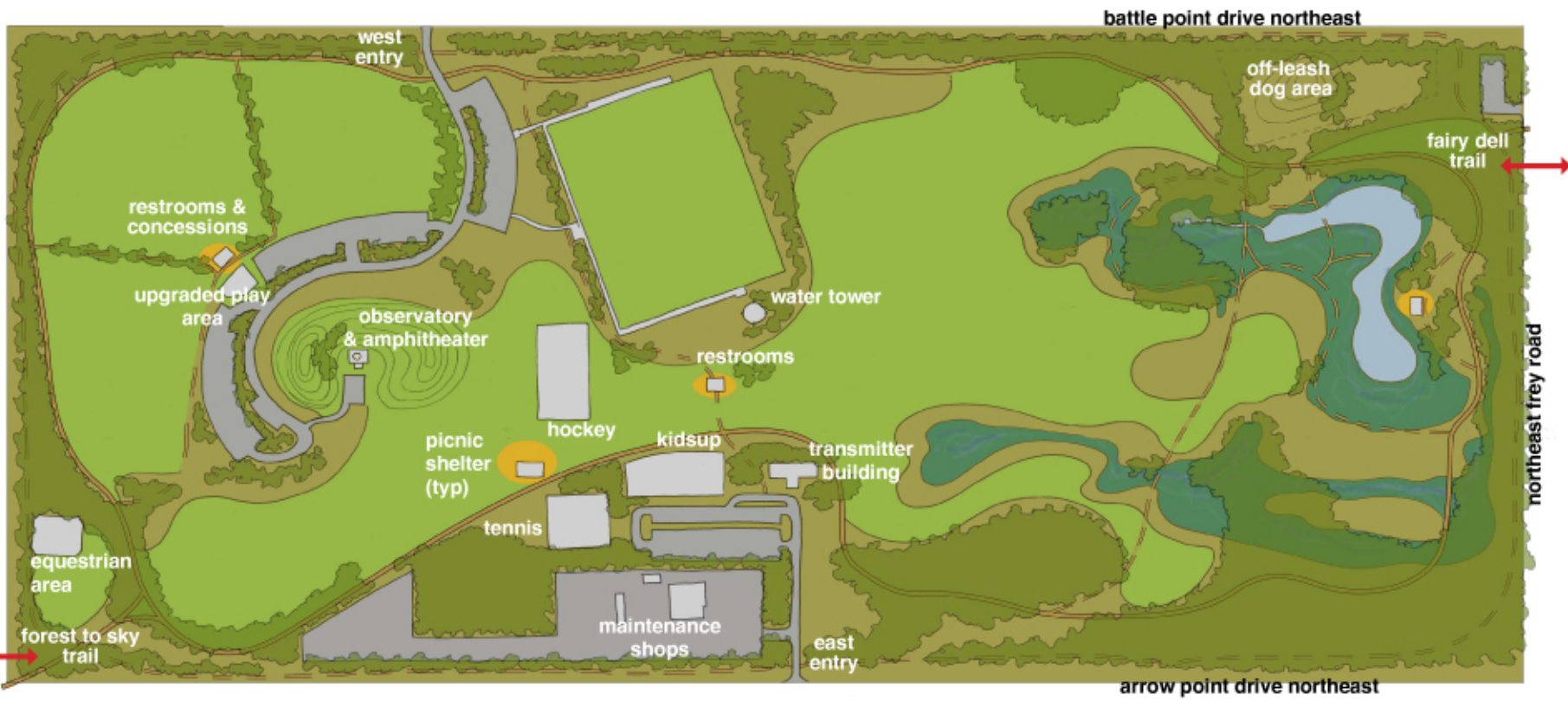
Exercise 2

Battle Point Park Master Plan Update

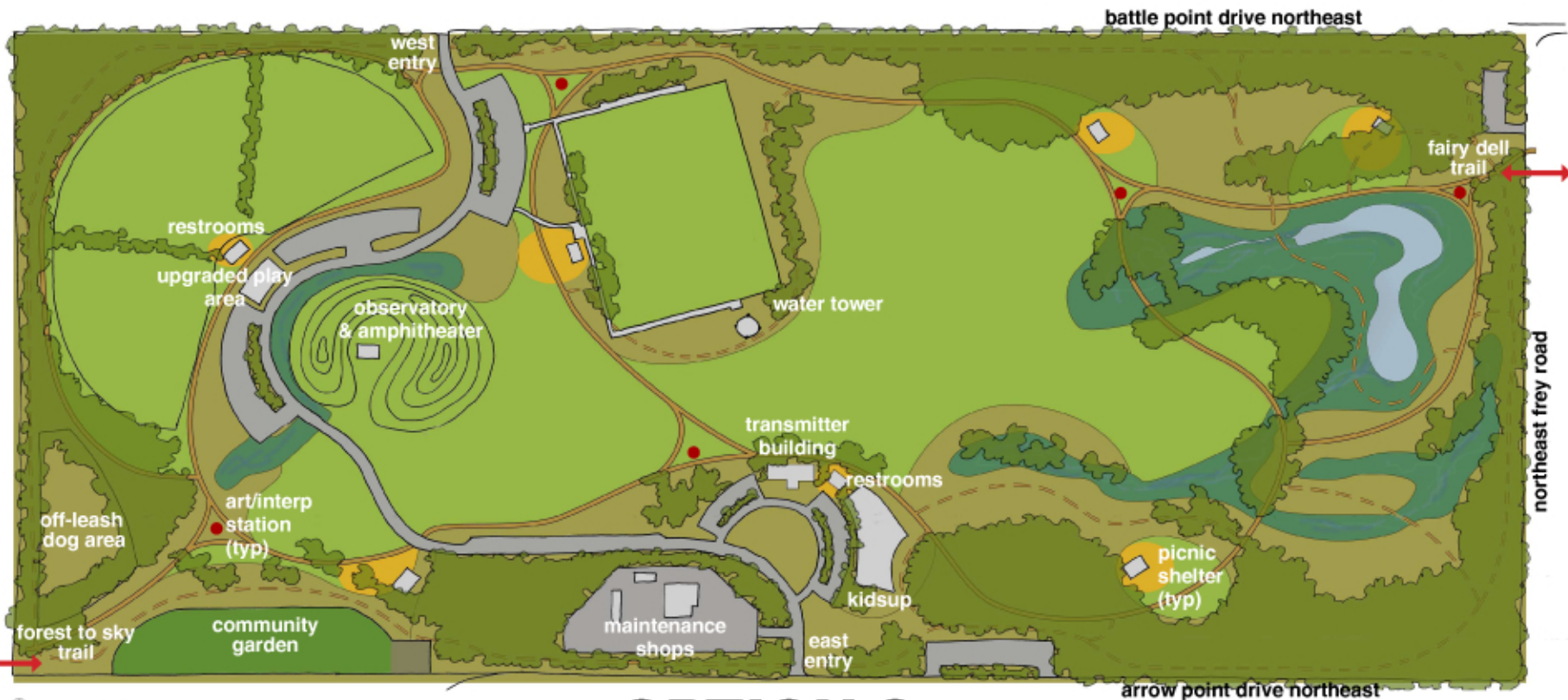

This worksheet outlines the differences between two plan options that follow. This exercise was used to solicit public comment on potential changes and design options for the park through 2022. The goal of the exercise was to query public preferences of various systems and elements in the park – not to select one option or another.

	Systems:	
some lawn to meadow, some wetland/woodland restoration	Vegetation and Drainage	more open views, some lawn to meadow, some wetland/woodland restoration, more natural drainage
expand one main loop , improve outer loop	Pedestrian Access and Circulation	more main trails and variety of loops, improve secondary and outer loop
improve turnarounds and parking on two dead-end accesses	Auto Access, Circulation, and Parking	re-connect access between entries, improve parking for
	Elements:	
expand on site in place of community gardens- 3 to 5 acres	Maintenance Shop	limit to current footprint and reconfigure access, district-wide services expand elsewhere – 1 to 2 acres
retain on site and expand	Tennis Courts	move to another site where they can grow to accommodate a tennis club facility
move to another site where they can expand	Community Gardens	expand on site toward material storage and west toward trails
retain on site	Equestrian Features	remove corral, keep outer loop as equestrian trail
None or add in northwest corner around hill	Off-Leash Dog Area	add in place of equestrian corral
retain in current location , repair as necessary	KidsUp and Playgrounds	move to northeast of transmitter building to open up central views
retain on site , but prohibit roof structure	Roller Hockey/Basketball	move to another site where a large roof structure would be appropriate
one large shelter centrally located	Picnic Shelters	several smaller shelters throughout the park—at community garden, soccer, and various north end openings
Limit to mounds at observatory	Art/Interpretation Stations	distribute throughout the park at key intersections, viewpoints, and destinations
repair existing	Restrooms	repair at ballfield , move central location to north side of transmitter building, potential third to be shared by observatory and soccer
repair existing at ballfield	Concessions	repair at ballfield and potential new near observatory
allow informal use near observatory	Amphitheater	expand and formalize landform around observatory to accommodate large events
Remove fence and create pedestrian openings	Park Perimeter Fence	No change
