# Public Meeting #1

## Ted Olson Nature Preserve Master Plan

### Goals

- To have an open, transparent, and accountable master plan process
- To listen to and understand community values and vision for the Preserve
- To be respectful of all users, property owners, and residents
- Optimize the community use and natural systems of the Preserve
- Share opportunities and limitation of the properties including Deed Restrictions, Comp Plan findings, and CIP meeting outcomes
- Develop a plan for physical improvements for the Preserve

### Outcomes

- Community participation and acknowledgement of the process and outcomes
- An implementable and phased master plan that guides physical develop of the Preserve
- A master plan that enhances community use and natural systems of the Preserve
- Stronger community stewardship of the Preserve

### Process

- **Public Meeting #1** – 12 November 2009
  - The case for a master plan – why a master plan / what it is / what needs to be known
  - Review and refine goals
  - Identify the Preserve's physical assets and value to the community – creating a vision
  - Discuss opportunities and concerns
  - Discuss development opportunities – physical changes / enhance natural systems / etc.
    - Including - kiosks / trail improvements / new trails / parking improvements / accessibility / restoration / etc.
  - Discuss Park Steward program and volunteer opportunities
- **Findings from Public Meeting #1** – 3 December 2009
  - Meeting notes and other documents to be placed on the Parks' website
  - Findings to be presented the Park Board
  - Develop summary of findings and develop alternatives for master plan improvements
- **Public Meeting #2** – 10 December 2009
  - Review and discussion of Meeting #1 findings
  - Review and discussion of master plan improvement alternatives
  - Discussion of final master plan
- **Findings from Public Meeting #2** – 29 December 2009
  - Meeting notes and other documents to be placed on the Parks' website
  - Findings and recommendations to be presented the Park Board
- **Draft Master Plan** – end of January 2010
  - Review at Park Board meeting
- **Final Master Plan** – mid February 2010
