Info and Contest Rules

Kitsap Has Talent is open to Kitsap teens 12-18 years of age. Any solo act that is safe and family friendly is welcome! We must have a minimum of 20 participants for the show to run. Registration deadline is January 25. We will notify you by January 26 if the show is going to run or if it needs to be cancelled.

Schedule and Locations:

Registration Deadline: January 25

Auditions – January 28 and January 29, 1:30-5:30pm

First Show – February 11, 1:00-5:00pm

Final Show – February 25, 7:00-10:00pm

All activities take place at Island Center Hall, 8395 Fletcher Bay Rd, Bainbridge Island, WA

Audition Information:

You must register for an audition slot for January 28 or January 29 via our online registration system or by calling our office at 206-842-2306 ext 118. Registration deadline is January 25. Audition fee is \$6.

Please arrive at Island Center Hall not later than 1:30. Auditions will be held first come, first served. We'd like everyone in and settled so auditions are not interrupted by latecomers.

Each audition slot is 90 seconds from beginning of act to cutoff.

Audition material should be similar to what you would perform at a show. It does not have to be identical, just representative. Ie, if you juggle at the audition, you'd need to juggle at the shows!

Bring a cd with only the music you want played on it – ie, we don't want to have to search for the music. We should just be able to pop it in and hit 'play'.

A piano will be available, but you will need to provide your own accompanist.

Three judges will score each act on: Entertainment value, level of skill and originality. Feedback and suggestions will be provided.

You will be notified on Monday, January 30 if you will move on to the first show.

Show Information:

Tickets for audience members will be available at the door for \$10. Participants do not need to pay anything other than the original audition fee.

At the shows, we will provide a simple PA system, two mics, cd player and piano. You may have a musical backup track or have an accompanist on piano or other instrument.

First show each act is 3 minutes from beginning to cutoff. Final show can run up to 5 minutes.

We have a small elevated stage for stationary acts, and open wooden floor space for those who need to move around, dance, etc.

Judges will provide feedback and opinions after each act.

At the end of the shows, audience members will vote by placing their ticket stubs in envelopes with participants' names on them. Names of those moving on to the final show will be announced after the first show just as soon as we can tally the votes. At the final show, the top three contestants will be announced and certificates awarded. Checks for the top three in the amounts of \$100, \$75 and \$50 will be mailed out the next business day.
